### Read the rules & guidelines!

Many photo contests are now **online entries only**. Be sure to read rules and guidelines carefully because every contest is different. The organizers of contests WANT you to win so they tell you as much as they can about what the judges are looking for.

The agriculture contest, for instance, allows photos that include domestic farm animals, but not animals typically associated with wildlife. So the best owl or squirrel picture in the world is still not going to win an award in that contest.
