## **New Master Naturalist training announced**

If you are interested in nature and the great outdoors, the Texas Master Naturalist (TMN) class is for you. It's not a club you can join. Classes meet two Tuesdays a month for six months, plus some Saturday field trips. You learn natural resources, conservation, preservation of wildlife, native plants and ecosystems and a lot of "-ologies" from archaeology to zoology.

TMN offers in-depth training taught by experts and customized to focus on the native plants and animals of our area. The local chapter, Longleaf Ridge Master Naturalist (LRMN) begins training a new group to become Certified Texas Master Naturalists on Tuesday, August 9, from 6 to 9 pm at Martin Dies Jr. State Park, 11 miles west of Jasper.

Classes take approximately six months to complete. Field trips teach volunteers to observe nature and include hands-on experience in involvement in citizen scientist programs. Pre-registration required.
