## SCHOLARSHIPS & ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Texas 4-H Youth Development Program Opportunity Scholarships are **ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS** awarded each year to applicants based on their academic record, 4-H experience, and financial need (for scholarships for which it is a required criterion). The scholarship Program is conducted in coordination with the TX 4-H Youth Development Program, the TX 4-H Youth Development Foundation and TX A&M AgriLife Extension Service. All applications must be submitted through the applicant's county Extension office and meet all criteria to be considered.

Approximately 225 academically-competitive scholarships were awarded in 2014 in the 4-H Scholarship program, ranging in amounts from \$1000 to \$20,000 (amount established by donor). For the majority of the total scholarships and scholarship funds available, participation in a livestock show is not a requirement for consideration for an Opportunity Scholarship. 





**YMBL** Exhibitors Poultry Orders & entry form with money are due to the YMBL office by October 3rd. You will need to contact the Extension office to get a signed Poultry entry form prior to sending in your entry.

**YMBL** Exhibitors - Lamb, Goat & Swine Tag orders and money are due, to your club manager or the Extension office by September 26th.

**IF YOU ARE PLANNING TO SHOW A LIVESTOCK PROJECT AT OUR COUNTY SHOW IN MARCH OF 2020**, you will need to be a bonified 4-H Member prior to county validation September 28th for cattle, and December 14th for small animals. 


