The New Normal

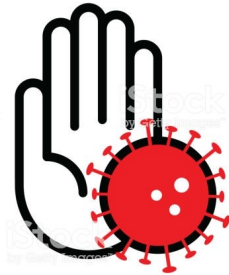
As we start moving toward the “new normal”, we still need to proceed with caution.

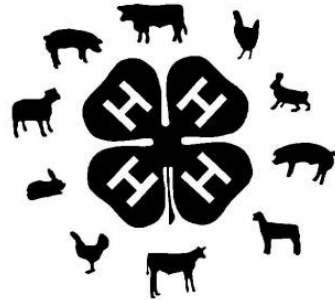

But you must be at least 18 years old – or 21 years old to chaperone overnight trips – and pass a criminal background check outlined in the [Volunteer Screening Manual](#). [Review protecting our youth guidelines](#) to learn about what goes into working with youth under 18. Based on your specific role, we'll let you know what level of training you may need, such as completion of Child Protection Training.

You decide the level of involvement that fits your skills and schedule, such as:

- Lead community clubs, school-based or after-school programs and camp settings
- Serve as chaperone, board member, event judge or camp counselor.
- Create community service opportunities for youth in your area
- Work with other adults to create fun and exciting programs

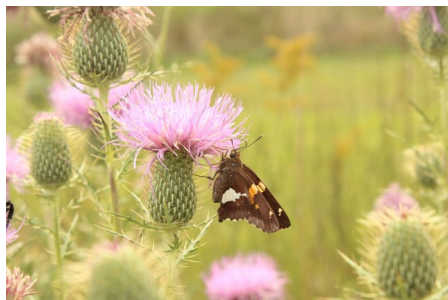
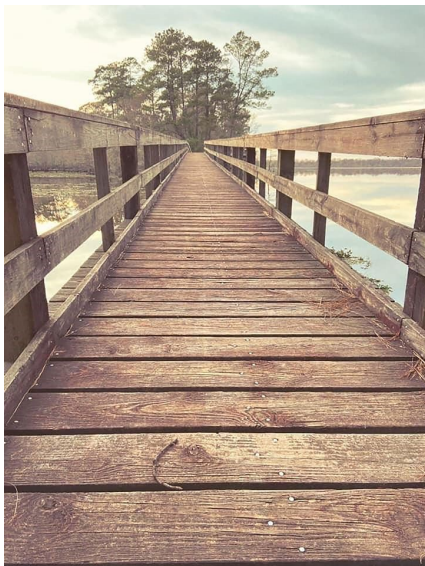
